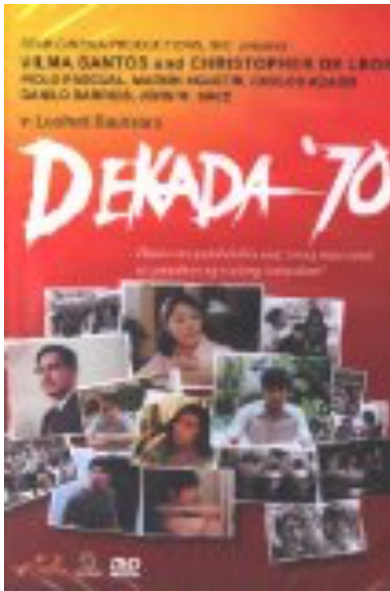




Philippine Study Group of Minnesota (PSGM)
